Literacy

- Develop phonemic awareness
- Practise and review single letter sounds and forms
- Introduction to 2-3 letter combinations in oral and written form
- Introduction to long vowel letter combinations in oral and written form
- Develop spelling by building CVC (Consonant-Vowel-Consonant) words
- · Learn to recognise a range of sight words
- · Develop a love of reading through guided reading activities
- · Improve writing skills with a focus on pencil grip and letter formation

Early Critical Thinking

- · Fun and engaging communicative activities
- · Art artistic utensils and creativity
- Music time instruments, actions and sounds
- · Weather different weather and describing sounds
- Performing nouns for entertainment
- Play Time vocabulary of games and prepositions of place
- · Saying Sorry apologising and helping others
- · Building Time working together
