What are the Alumni Awards?

- The Study UK Alumni Awards find and celebrate the impact that outstanding international UK alumni have made on their professions, societies, and countries where they now live.
- Alumni Award winners and finalists are leaders in their fields entrepreneurs, professionals and social leaders – who have used their experience of studying at a UK university to make a positive contribution in their communities, professions and countries.
- Through the Alumni Awards, winners are given the opportunity to professionally develop and build their capacity and professional networks, contributing to the overall development of their country.
- By identifying the success stories of international UK alumni, and their impact upon the countries they're living in, the Alumni Awards raise the profile of UK education globally and promote the UK as a study destination for international students.

Award categories

Business and Innovation Award

- Recognising alumni who are active in initiating and contributing to innovative or creative new ideas, solutions or business opportunities, that have the potential for growth.
- Areas of work could include, but are not limited to: entrepreneurship, business, technology and finance.

Culture and Creativity Award

- Recognising alumni who have carved a career for themselves in arts and culture. These are individuals who can demonstrate their artistic ingenuity, influence and creativity.
- Areas of work could include, but are not limited to: arts, design, humanities, traditional media, music, video, TV, sports and online content and audiovisual media creation (e.g blogging, vlogging including for social media).





Award categories

Science and Sustainability Award

- Recognising alumni who have distinguished themselves through their career and achievements in the world of science and sustainability, and who can demonstrate the impact and scale of their achievements in their profession, and beyond.
- Areas of work could include, but are not limited to: climate action, clean energy, medicine, sustainable cities and communities, engineering, industry and construction.

Social Action Award

- Recognising alumni who have made an exceptional contribution and commitment to creating positive social change and improving the lives of others.
- Areas of work could include, but are not limited to: education, peace and justice and reducing inequality, poverty and hunger and broader humanitarian work or work for social good.

Alumni can select the category they wish to apply for. However, judging panels may re-assign applications to a different category during the judging process, if appropriate.
