Primary

Our winter programme focusses on learning all about our world through engaging and exciting topics with real world application. This holistic programme combines a focus on the academic skills needed for success at school and in exams, while building confidence in collaboration, public speaking, writing for different audiences and outcomes, critical thinking and sharing informed opinions.

Primary Plus and value added lessons use stimulating materials and activities such as games, music and tasks that employ logic and higher-order thinking to appeal to children of all learning inclinations and preferences. Classes support children in their personal, social and emotional development as well as in developing important 21st-century skills.

Our aim is to provide a positive and inclusive environment where children are free to express themselves and ask questions. Lessons relate to children's personal experience, with each child being treated as an individual so that language can arise naturally.

We believe that the key to children's future success involves combining key language skills with core skills around:

- Leadership and personal development
- Critical thinking and problem-solving
- Collaboration and communication
- Creativity and imagination
- Digital literacy
- Citizenship

To build core life skills, children tackle real-life tasks, working in groups and crafting researched answers and innovative solutions. The tasks are specially designed to match their developmental age, ensuring familiarity to the situation they learn in. Children communicate and engage with a variety of media, leading them to work collaboratively as well as to become more self-directed.
